News for City Hall - Overbrook PRIDE and Overbrook Parks and Recreation recently applied for a grant through the Overbrook Community Foundation. This would be the same grant from the Patterson Foundation that we received last year to pave the path to the pickleball court!

The grant application is for these four items: Install Heating and Air Conditioning in the Old Gym Building, New sidewalks on the west side of Maple Street from City Hall north to Highway 56, Replace the scoreboards at Jones Park, Install Sunshades at both ballfield backstops at Jones Park.

During the month of August, we will be sharing the details of the progress on our website and social media.

In September, PRIDE and OPR will be conducting a fundraising campaign for the matching funds for the grant. The stipulations of the grant application are that the fundraising occurs during a 30-day window. To best accomplish this, the two groups will collaborate in their fundraising activities. The goal will be to raise \$70,000.00.

Feeding Wildlife – The city would like to remind citizens do not feed the wildlife that is in our area. Feeding wild animals can be dangerous to both humans and animals. Here are some reasons why you should avoid feeding wild animals: Feeding habituates animals to certain areas, making them lose their fear of humans. Wild animals fed by humans can easily become malnourished. Feeding wild animals can interrupt their normal migration patterns. Feeding attracts large groups of animals from all different areas, which can spread diseases that are transmitted between the animals.
